

Mr. Yen Yuen Ho Tony, S.B.S., J.P.

Mr. Yen Yuen Ho Tony, S.B.S., J.P. is a solicitor in Hong Kong and England. He is also a barrister and solicitor in Australia. Before retiring as a civil servant, he served the HKSAR government in the capacity of the Law Draftsman of the Department of Justice. In 2000, he was awarded a Silver Bauhinia Star medal by the Chief Executive of the HKSAR.

In the area of education, Mr. Yen is now an Honorary Court Member of the Hong Kong University of Science & Technology, and an Honorary Fellow of the Faculty of Education, University of Hong Kong. Besides serving as an Adjunct Professor at Hong Kong Shue Yan University and Beijing Normal University, Mr. Yen has also been appointed as a director of Hong Kong Institute of Public Administration, the Supervisor of Kiangsu-Chekiang College (Shatin) as well as a school manager of Kiangsu-Chekiang College and Creative Secondary School.

Among his public service activities, Mr. Yen is currently the Chairman of the Neighbourhood Advice Action Council, an Honorary Advisor to Pok Oi Hospital and the Honorary Consultant of the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing. From April 2009 to April 2015, Mr. Yen was the Vice Chairman of the Social Welfare Lump Sum Grant Independent Complaints Handling Committee. From January 2013 to January 2018, he served as a member of the Panel of Review Board on School Complaints set up by the Education Bureau.
